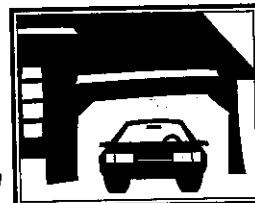
Read James 2:14-26.

 - D. Praying for sick people to get well.

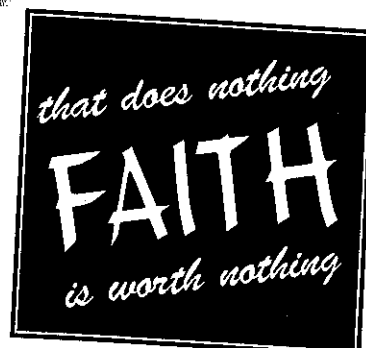
What would have happened if Noah had thought that faith was all he needed?
